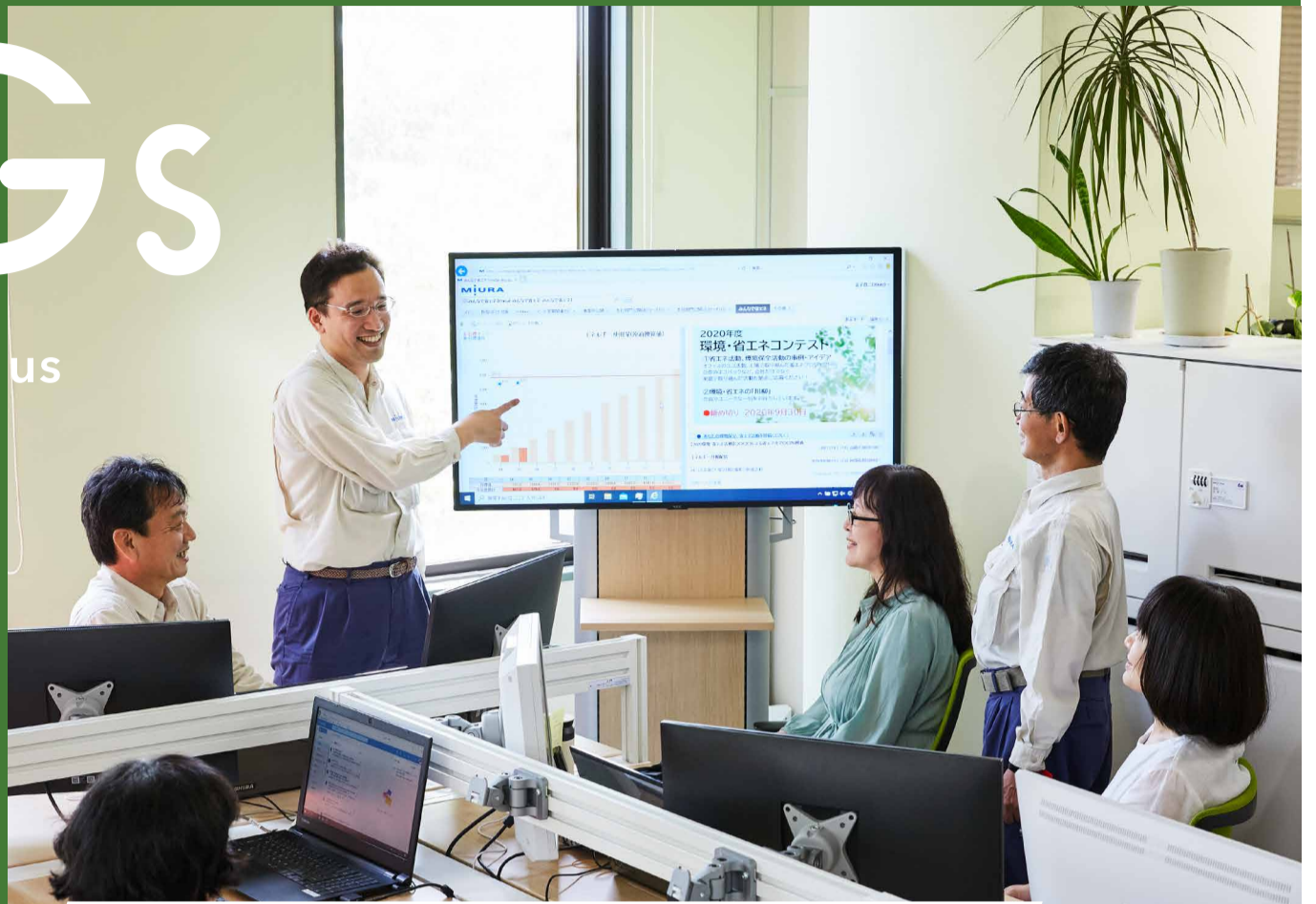

In 2018, we started our "Zero Emissions Challenge 2030" target for the reduction of CO₂ and waste.
