Recycling waste efficiently allows us to be kind to the earth and contribute to improving the local environment.

Having greenery close at hand also helps people to relax and take a break from their hectic schedules. We look after the waterways and trees in the areas around the MIURA headquarters building, as well as the decorative plants we have indoors. Part of the green areas we maintain are open to local residents, and we often talk with strolling visitors who talk about the beautiful gardens and ask us what kind of blooms we have planted. We also provide a service through which we deliver Phalaenopsis orchids on request to customers to commemorate events such as new constructions or the delivery of products. 2020 saw immense changes in the way we work, and we created environments to facilitate remote working for each of our locations. Going forward, we will work to help the MIURA Group grow and flourish as a behind-the-scenes force.
