



## Transfer Procedure of Miura BWMS Operation Data

- 1) Turn off the breaker of the control panel.
- 2) Press the SD card installed behind the touch panel for the control panel toward inserting direction once, remove the SD card. (There is no SD card in the touch panel for the remote control panel.)

- 3) Copy all data in the SD card to your computer using a card reader etc.

Copy the data by folder.

4) The operation records are divided into several folders as follows, send all data stored in the SD card to MIURA by email.

If it is not possible due to the large capacity, send them in several times.
