This is to inform you about operation data transfer of our ballast water management system (Miura BWMS).

- •According to the MEPC.300(72)4.20, vessels must keep an operation data of the ballast water management system at least two years. When exchanging the SD card, the recorded data must be kept onboard for another two years.
- •Miura BWMS operation record, such as alarm data, operation data and maintenance data, are stored on the SD card in the touch panel. If the power is cut off while the battery built in the touch panel is dead, data loss or automatic operation failure may occur, so replace the battery before the expiration date.

From the perspective of preventive maintenance,

we propose transferring Miura BWMS operation data stored on the SD card at the time of trouble or before docking. Our engineer will check the operation record, alarm record and operation condition at the time of issuing alarm, and recommend an appropriate replacement parts or inspection to you for using the Miura BWMS safely and for a longer period.

When you transfer the data, send all the data stored in the SD card.
