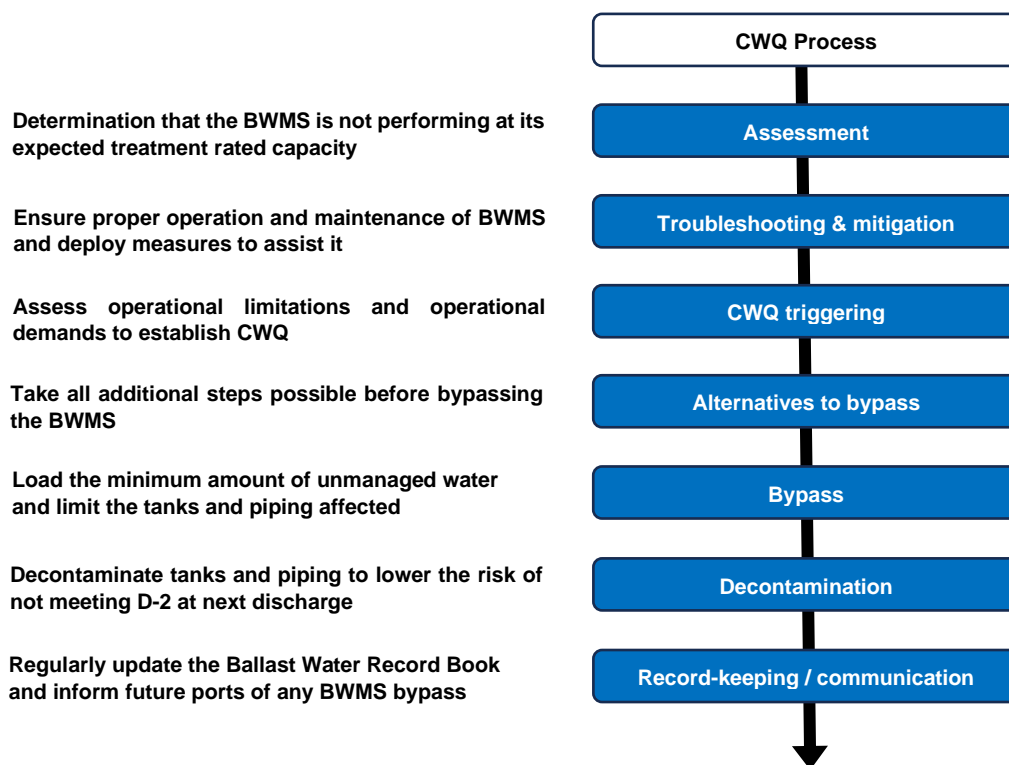


The process of complying with the CWQ in the use of MIURA BWMS (Model:HK)

The following is a simplified process for the Challenging Water Quality (CWQ), where the use of the ballast water management system 'Miura BWMS' makes normal continuous operation difficult. Please note that the obligation to comply with the D-2 standard has not and will not be eliminated and bypassing is a last resort. The practical steps in the preparation of a BWMP and the series of operations during a CWQ encounter should be based on MEPC Resolution 387(81) 'Interim Guidance on the Application of the BWM Convention in the Event of a CWQ Encounter'. As an assist, we are providing evaluation and operating procedures for BWMS, which are necessary for the CWQ response process. Please refer to the attached document for further details.
